The Aster Group is, non-profit housing association which provides quality, affordable homes to thousands of people across the South of England and London, owning a stock portfolio of over 37,000.

Drews Park was once a psychiatric hospital, decommissioned in 1995 and then converted into private and social residences.

The stunning architecture of the building remained, with the principal building constructed of stone from the Murhill quarry.

In 2022, 148 of Aster properties at Drews Park required external repairs and redecoration and, after a competitive tender process, Hankinson Whittle was awarded the 24-week contract.

The site forms several courtyards and interesting shaped layouts.



Scope of Works

The Aster Group chose Hankinson Whittle for our reputation of ensuring that we can develop and deliver decoration projects which maintain the aesthetic and physical integrity of properties with architecture such as this.



Works Included:

Repair and redecoration of the existing doors and windows to the houses, flats and communal areas of the site.

Pre-paint repairs and re-decoration of all fascia's and soffits to the building.

Painted timber features to the main building and Clock Tower.

Sanitary ware or hardware where possible.
